

WHAT DOES CASA DO?

FOLLOW A CASA VOLUNTEER'S JOURNEY TO HELP A CHILD FIND A FOREVER HOME




A child is removed from home and placed into foster care




The judge appoints a CASA volunteer and the organization contacts them

CASA volunteer interviews everyone involved in the case - advocates also hold a court order to review any type of document filed for child or parents
